Requirements for this position include being a registered and licensed occupational therapist with a terminal doctoral degree, which may be a post-professional OTD, PhD or EdD (consideration will also be given to candidates who have made substantial progress towards the completion of a doctorate); 3+ years of clinical experience; previous teaching experience; and eligibility for licensure in the state of Missouri. Responsibilities of this 11-month tenure-track position includes teaching and advising students, conducting and mentoring research, and participating in Department and University committees. Candidates with a focused interest in geriatric and mental health populations, adult rehabilitation, and assistive technology are highly encouraged to apply. Salary, rank, and benefits will be determined based on experience and qualifications.
